Bangor Air National Guard's new hangar

The Bangor Air National Guard's new hangar earned a LEED Silver rating from the United States Green Building Council. (USGBC). Designed to house the Guard's KC-135 refueling aircraft, the facility was constructed using a Butler pre-engineered building designed and fabricated in **Butler's Heavy Structures** division. The design called for a 200 foot clear-span structure with sliding aircraft doors with approximately 23,500-squarefoot hangar constructed by **Sheridan Construction** Corporation.

Designed and built with energy conservation in mind, Building 499 will receive a LEED Silver rating from the United States Green Building Council, which administers the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design program. The Bangor ANG Base will be the first such Air Guard facility to receive this rating for a new building.
