In 1994, The Sheridan Corporation constructed a 68,000-square-foot edition to the current standing General Electric manufacturing facility in Bangor, Maine. This project features new manufacturing & office space, support facilities as well as renovations to the current standing building.

Due to the nature of the environment, the mechanical and electrical requirements are intensive. Large air handlers were installed on the mezzanine level of the facility in order to meet HVAC requirements. Additionally, spiral ducts run the entire length of the building, and piping for compressed air and gases for welding processes were distributed throughout the plant.
